I am pleased to invite you to the **ETUC's 2024 annual European Works Council Conference**, to be held on **26-27 September 2024 in Brussels** in person. The Conference will start at 11am CET on 26 September and finishes after lunch on 27 September.

This conference holds special significance as we celebrate several key milestones: commemorating 30 years of the EWC Directive, reflecting on two decades since the EU's big enlargement towards Eastern & Central Europe, and marking a pivotal moment post-EU elections. Furthermore, the conference occurs just before the European co-legislators will take up trilogue negotiations on the revision of the EWC Directive.
